Background information:

The INTENSE national agreement between Mongolian partners has been signed on 26th April 2019. The objective of the agreement is to establish and to strengthen the INTENSE national program for graduate study. As agreed Mongolian partners of the INTENSE project, the annual meeting will be organized in next years. The first day (17 June 2021) of the visit:

The NUM team leader, Professor O.Altansukh and Rector of the Khovd University, Professor B.Nyamdorj introduced the INTENSE outputs and its impact on their universities. The third and fourth days (19-20 June 2021) of the visit:

Due to the COVID restriction, the agenda slightly changed, and the team visited Ovor Zaisan summer school camp of the NUM instead of Gorkhi-Terelj national park.

Joint team visited Ovor Zaisan summer school camp in Bogd Khaan strictly protected area and have seen an opportunity to organize joint summer school. Professor Ch.Sonomdagva introduced study and research activities at the camp. Associate professor N.Oyunchimeg introduced special protected area management issues near the big city and organized the walking tour.



The fifth day (21 June 2021) of the visit:

Joint team visited the University Forest camp in Batsumber soum, Tov aimag. Professor B.Oyunsanaa introduced study and research activities at the camp.



The sixth day (22 June 2021) of the visit:

The Khovd team visited research laboratories and center of the Department of environment and forest engineering. During the visit, several active discussions between professors have been held, including glacier study of western region, Mongolia.



The seventh day (23 June 2021) of the visit:

Professor Bayarkhuu, Khovd University, and Professor Altansukh, NUM are working on quality control of the INTENSE outputs. Both parties are cross-checking their deliverables. They found some mistakes and giving each other how to fulfill the requirement.



The eight day (24 June 2021) of the visit:

The guest team went back to the Khovd.

Conclusion:

The first annual meeting of the INTENSE national program was organized successfully. Due to the COVID restriction, some changes have been made in the agenda. However, the organizing team changed the destination and visited the student summer camp instead of Gorkhi-Terelj national park. Moreover, cross-checking of the INTENSE outputs has been made and identified several not completed deliverables, including stakeholder review of the e-courses, sharing research facility report, and student evaluation.

Decision:

Background information:

The project is globally important for PCs and EU as it addresses major environmental challenges in PCs, which are caused by poorly formulated policies, inadequate selection of management actions and the lack of suitable technology. They need to be addressed by high quality multidisciplinary and end user-oriented research.

Higher education and research in MN, UA, VN have developed for long after USSR organisational and conceptual model, and under the transition to market-based economy and globalisation of societies and economies of PCs, doctoral provision had similar problems identified by many national and international observers. For instance, although PhD/aspirantura studies in PCs are recognised as a part of HE system, they are insufficient for developing academic competencies by PhD students, both in relation to subject-specific and transferable skills. The shared problems of PCIs manifest in the poor quality of many dissertations, and in low acceptance rates of papers submitted to international journals, mostly because the research is based on inadequate knowledge of and hence reference to international literature and poor methodology. It is important to address these issues by improving the governance of doctoral training and introducing a robust QA culture.

The project aims:

- To improve the practice of doctoral training and professionalise its governance by integrating PhD programs dealing with environmental policy, management and technology in 7 PCIs to 3 nationwide integrated doctoral schools (INTENSE NIDS), based on common Code of Operational Practices & research framework (COP & RF), and consolidating these schools into the INTENSE International Network.
- 2. To enhance doctoral training provision by integrating and upgrading existing learning contents that can be used for doctoral provision (total 80 ECTS by M36), infrastructure for accessing the courses and setting&monitoring flexible research training trajectories and their progression (INTENSE open education platform, including sustainable mechanisms for its development and maintenance) and shared access to research facilities.
- 3. To build the capacity of PhD students to improve their published output, through a strengthened multidisciplinary approach to doctoral training, aided by facilitating access to global and EU research networks (including facilitation of academic mobility), development of transferable skills, promotion of joint research/supervision arrangements & interdisciplinary & practice-oriented thesis topics.




Friday, 19 June 2021 - The University Forest camp 1 hour 30-minute driving distance from the hotel.




Saturday, 20 June 2021 - Gorkhi-Terelj national park 3 hour driving distance from the University forest camp
