INTENSE PROJECT AIMS:

- ~ To build the capacity of PhD students to improve their published output, through a strengthened multidisciplinary approach to doctoral training, aided by facilitating access to global and EU research networks (including facilitation of academic mobility), development of transferable skills, promotion of joint research/supervision arrangements & interdisciplinary & practice-oriented thesis topics.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT:

The summer school is open to 3 staffs and 3 graduate students (preferable to PhD students) of NUM.

APPLICATION:

All applicants are invited to provide the following information:

- ~ Application form
- ~ Citizenship card
- ~ Student or employment card
- ~ The vaccination certificate
- ~ CV

The applicants should send e-mail with all relevant materials to altansukh@seas.num.edu.mn with the following subject: “APPLICATION TO INTENSE SUMMER SCHOOL”. Applications for admission must be submitted within August 10 2021.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The students selection will be carried out by the organizing committee (NUM+KHU+MULS) on the basis of the received documents and interview with candidates. The interview will take place on 12th August 2021 via Google meeting. The Commission will evaluate each candidate by 1-10 points. The list of selected participants will be notified with an email same day.

CERTIFICATION:

A participation certificate will be obtained only if the participant fully attends the summer school.

SCHOLARSHIP:

All expenses, including travel insurance, international travel, accommodation cost and etc., will be covered by INTENSE project.

EVALUATION:

In total, 4 applicant's documents were received within 10 August 2021 via altansukh@seas.num.edu.mn. The evaluation was carried out by the commission on the basis of the received documents and interview with candidates. The interview carried out on 12th August 2021 via Google meeting.


SELECTION:


